In fact, our Code of Ethics covers more protected classes than the Federal legislation. The REALTORS® Code prohibits discrimination by race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status, sexual orientation, gender identity and national origin. And recently, the Code of Ethics has been expanded to conduct outside of real estate practices.


The bill includes \$85 million directly to the agencies that do the most to protect fair housing. In addition, the bill provides billions of additional dollars for affordable housing loans and grants. Finally, the legislation had nearly \$100 million for housing counseling and legal aid.

In North Carolina, the most recent state budget bill included \$180 million for a workforce housing loan program. We need more, diverse housing available so we can keep housing affordable for all North Carolinians.

Fair Housing Month is a time to remember that we all have a part to play in ensuring equal access to housing for all. More than 50 years after the passage of the landmark Fair Housing Act, there is still work to do, and NC REALTORS® are committed to leading the way. As we like to say: We Open Doors to Everyone.
